Residential trip to Osmington Bay

We are delighted to offer the opportunity of a residential trip to Osmington Bay in Dorset with PGL.

Year 6 is a challenging year academically for students – particularly with the focus on national assessments in Reading, Writing and Maths. This residential trip, post-SATs, is an opportunity for students to further develop their inter-personal and social skills combined with the challenge of some new and exciting physical experiences such as climbing, abseiling, archery and raft building. There is a focus on team building activities and students often make great personal progress during the time spent away from home.

This trip is classed as an optional extra to our Curriculum and as such will be chargeable. The trip will take place from Friday 5th June 2020, leaving school about 9.30 a.m. and returning at approximately 6.30 p.m. on the evening of Monday 8th June. The cost of the trip is £250, with the option of spreading the payment over the coming months with a final balance due towards the end of March 2019.
