

## YEAR 7 CATCH-UP PREMIUM

The Year 7 catch-up premium is a fund to support pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading and/or maths at the end of Key Stage 2.

Holywell School received £11,214 in catch-up premium in 2019-20. This additional grant is being used:

- for interventions to improve the attainment of students who did not achieve national standards at the end of KS2 assessments in 2019.

### Year 7 Catch-up intervention programme

Intervention	Strategy	Intended impact
Small focused group intervention for English	An intensive intervention programme is delivered by a subject specialist in intervention withdrawal sessions.	Focused intervention to gain maximum impact. Personalised learning approach to support individual's needs.  Develop spelling, punctuation, grammar skills, reading and comprehension.
Small focused group intervention for maths	An intensive intervention programme is delivered by a subject specialist in intervention withdrawal sessions tailored to the needs of the students.	Focused intervention to gain maximum impact. Personalised learning approach to support individual's needs.  Develop rapid recall of facts eg number bonds, times tables, arithmetic methods.  Develop problem solving skills using key facts in real life contexts.
Student support resources	Additional resources to support all Year 7 students in English and Maths	Improved wave 1 teaching in Maths and English.

### IMPACT 2019-2020

The impact of this intervention programme will be reported on at the end of the academic year.

### Maths

28 students did not achieve the expected standard in Maths in 2018.

### Reading

43 students did not achieve the expected standard in Reading in 2019.

### Writing

45 students did not achieve the expected standard in Writing in 2019.
